

Zonta Mission: Zonta International is a global organization of professionals working together to advance the status of women worldwide through service and advocacy.

Zonta Vision: Zonta International envisions a world in which women's rights are recognized as human rights and every woman is able to achieve her full potential. In such a world, women have access to all resources and are represented in decision-making positions on an equal basis with men. In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence.

What to Expect: Zonta members have the opportunity to meet professionals who want to help women reach their potential. Members socialize and network locally, nationally and internationally to empower women working in many different fields. In order to accomplish our goals, all Zontians are expected to participate actively in committees, meetings, service and events.

Meetings: The Zonta Club of Harrisburg-Hershey meets on the 2nd Thursday of each month from September through June for a short meeting at 6:00 pm followed by a speaker. During the covid pandemic, the meetings are held via Zoom calls. Potential members should plan to attend at least two meetings/events/conversations with members prior to acceptance in the club.

Fundraising: In order to accomplish the service objectives of the club, we participate in several fundraisers per year. Distribution of our service dollars include: support Shalom House (our selected partner in fulfilling our local mission), two scholarships and Zonta International (in support of our global mission).

Advocacy: The Zonta Club strives to collaborate with a global network of professionals who are committed to our campaign to advance the status of women and to end violence against women and children. The club strives to reach out to other like-minded organizations to collaborate on projects or events.
